<p>Know the signs of potential modern slavery/human trafficking</p> <p>Does someone living on your street or serving you in their job ... Show signs of physical or psychological abuse? Look malnourished or unkempt? Often wear the same clothes? Appear withdrawn or frightened? Appear under control or influence? Have little opportunity to move freely? Appear totally unfamiliar with the neighbourhood? Seem to be living and working at the same address? Live with a large number of seemingly unrelated people? Get picked up and dropped off again very early/late? Report any concerns safely to: Modern Slavery Helpline 08000 121700. More information at modernslaveryhelpline.org. Never approach someone you suspect is a victim of modern slavery, as you could be putting yourself and them in serious danger. Report safely as above or by calling the Police on 101.</p>
