English Martyrs School News

As part of their RE learning last week, EYFS and Year 1 had a Pentecost party. They wore flame hats and danced around like the wind to represent the Holy Spirit.

In Service Children's Club this term, the children created a poster with the dandelion which is the flower of the military child and they wrote some words round them to represent how resilient and strong they are. The dandelion represents each child's ability to take root and flourish anywhere the wind blows them. Military children are much like the dandelion. They are uprooted and replanted across the world.

A reflection from Pope Francis for the Year of Prayer, Sixth Sunday of Easter: We now consider the importance of perseverance in prayer.
