A reflection from Pope Francis for the Year of Prayer, First Sunday of Lent: The saints recognise that prayer is not always easy, for our human nature is frequently distracted or tempted by seemingly more important priorities. In our daily efforts to persevere in prayer may we trust that our own spiritual combat, like that of Jacob and the angel (Genesis 28:16), will bear fruit in a deeper and more mature relationship with the Lord.
