

<u>We are in the month of November</u>, which is traditionally the month when we remember the Faithful Departed. If you would like your loved ones to be remembered especially, please use the envelopes provided in the Church porch, along with the list of names and offering if you wish. The list of names will remain on the altar throughout the month.

<u>Cemetery Visit</u> On **Sunday 5**th **November at 3.00 pm**, we shall visit the Cemetery on Kilburn Road to pray the Rosary for all those buried there and to our departed loved ones.

School admissions to Catholic Primary Academies (Reception Year) Children born between 01/09/2019 and 31/08/2020, the deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 15th January 2024. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for, if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion, you should also complete a supplementary information form, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the supporting evidence* as required with this form, eg baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place. *If you do not have the required evidence, please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.
